English	RSHE	Options - Hair and Beauty
Students are following a fuctional skills course in English. This term we will concentrate on writing skills such as spelling, punctuation and sentence structure. We will also be including some creative writing. Reading at home is a great way to support your childs learning and will enhance their writing skills.	This term in RSHE we will be learning about drugs, alcohol and smoking. Students will learn about the effect and impacts of these. We will also focus on strategies for managing risk and accessing information and support.	This half term we will be looking at hair from the 1960s to present day, predominantly at how coloring techniques have changed over the years.
Mathematics	Careers	Options - Duke of Edinburgh - Silver Award
We are following functional skills mathematics. There are three components of study starting with 'Using numbers and the number system'. Students begin with simple sums and progress to approximation, rounding, fractions and decimals. The course focuses on learning to apply Maths skills to solve real life tasks.	This term we will explore different employment skills. We will be learning about the importance of attendance and time keeping in the work place. We will also focus on strategies to help us ensure work place activities are completed correctly.	This term the students will be practising setting up camp and doing their prastice expedition which consists of 3 days walking and two nights camping. The students will also be volunteering around the local area and within school. Students will discuss what physical activity they would like to do as a group and how we can fundraise for it.
Work Experience	Computing	Options - Construction
Students will be on work experince at NNDC Muddy Boots Volunteer group. Working alongside the rangers and public to help manage and conserve local beauty spots. Students will also have an opportunity to go to Strands Charity shop to experience a retail work environment.	Students will learn about various aspects of eSafety. Then continue to work towards AQA awards in areas such as ICT skills, networking, hardware and programming.	This term the students will be preapring wood and creating a picket fence for the sixth form garden. Students will be learning to safely use different hand tools for denailing, sanding, hammering and staining wood.
Life Skills	Options - Arts Award	Options - Animal Care
Independent Life Skills lessons focus on developing the skills needed to move towards independence. This term the focus is on kitchen hygiene, creating low cost meals and personal budgeting. The students will complete ASDAN LifeSkills challenges as they work through the course.	In the Autumn Term, the students will be given an introduction to the Art Award. We will be investigating the wide coverage of creative arts involved in terms of visual, performing and literal arts and how they interrelate.	In Animal Care students will be learning about wild and domesticated animals. This term will focus on learning about the diversity of animals and the different opportunities there are to work with them.
TITAN	Sports	Gardening
We are following the TITAN independent travel programme. This term will focus on the green cross code and pedestrian skills. We will be visiting local towns to practice these skills.	The focus this term is on Football and Basketball. Students will work on developing their skills in throwing, dribbling and passing. Students will also practice working with a partner and as part of a team.	Garden maintenance is the focus of this term. Activities will include watering, mowing, pruning, clearing and safely making bonfires. Students will learn to use tools safely, follow instructions and work as a team.
Asdan Personal development programme	Options - Food Wise	Options - Geography
This term we are completing the Health and Wellbeing Module. The challenges will focus on exploring ways to stay emotionally and physically healthy. We will learn about healthy eating, support for mental health and basic first aid.	In FoodWise this term we will be learning kitchen skills such as using knives and different cooking methods. We will be putting into practice food hygiene and safety knowledge whilst cooking dishes using autumn fruits.	We will be creating and completing a research project on popular local locations this term. Students will be creating questionnaires, going to the locations to gather data and then analysing and presenting their data.
