Maths

This term in Maths we will carry on with addition and subtraction. We will also look at 2D and 3D shapes. Pupils will learn to recognise and name 2D and 3D shapes. They will also look at properties of shapes including key vocabulary.

English

In English we are going to start with a new topic "Classic Fiction" and we are going to focus on "A Christmas Carol" story. Pupils are going to do activities around the story. They will be able to recall, sequence, retell and talk about this lovely story.

We will also carry on having Accelerate reading every day.

RSHE

This term in RSHE we will explore what it means to be frightened or worried and we will learn simple strategies we can use if we are feeling frightened or worried.

We will also be looking at how to take care of our bodies and keep them safe.

Science

This term in science we are going to be learning and practising different techniques for separating mixtures. We will learn about filtration, distillation chromatography and other methods to separate mixtures depending on their properties.



PE

During this half term lessons will be moving into the gym and hall where students will learn the basic skills involved in tennis. This will be delivered by a local tennis coach where the students will learn different types of shots and develop their knowledge of the game. The other PE lesson will be a mixture between fitness training such as boxing, circuits and multi skills activities.

Outdoor Learning

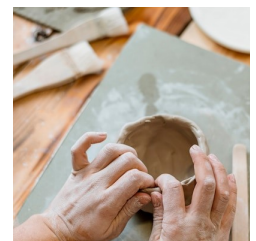
In outdoor learning we are going to carry on doing a lot of fun activities outside. This term we will focus on creating images using natural materials. We will be also looking at language to describe feelings and experiences.



We will do art Christmas decorations using different natural materials (twigs, leaves..)

Art

In art we will practice and refine drawing techniques. They will also learn how to mould, join and shape clay into basic shapes.
