After half term we will begin taking Maple class in small groups to the local shops to put into practice some of the independence skills we have been learning.



Maths



The class will continue to follow the White Rose Maths scheme of work in the main, moving on to operations this term at a level appropriate to the individual pupils. We will also be investigating money and finances more.

English

Following the previous half term Maple class will be learning about personal finance and the importance of keeping passwords and personal information safe as well as looking at how information is shared online.
