Maths

This term in Maths we are going to look at multiplication and division. They are going to learn to recognise equal groups, add equal groups, introduce the multiplication symbol, multiplication sentences, divide by 2, doubling and halving.



English



In English we will carry on doing activities around the book "Rock bottom", but we will also start with traditional poetry. We will focus on "The Highway man". Pupils are going to be able to respond to a classic poem, understand what a poem is and they will be able to contribute to class poems.

RSHE

In RSHE we will carry on talking about puberty and friendship but this term we are going to focus on elements of a healthy lifestyle. They will recognise what is meant by a healthy lifestyle and different ways that people can live a healthy lifestyle. They will also learn about healthy eating.



Science

This half term we will be starting our biology units which will predominantly focus on how living things move. We will cover topics such as the skeletal system, the muscular system and how these two work together to allow us to move. The students will have the opportunity to take part in various experiments related to these topics.

PE

In the first half term, Chestnut class will be practising their Athletics skills in preparation for Sports Day. They will learn to master basic movements including running, jumping, throwing as well as developing balance, agility and coordination, and begin to apply these in a range of activities. Chestnut class will also be trying out some footgolf.

Outdoor learning

With Summer 1 we will start with all the seasonal gardening activities. They will prepare the ground for cultivation, they will also describe the life cycle of a plant in simple terms, recognise plants that need sunlight, warmth, water and space to grow.



They will also recognise the importance and value of minibeasts to our environment, understand the importance of leaving minibeasts where they are found.

RE

In RE they will learn how the universe came to be.
