

Maths

The children will work on fractions to begin with by adding and subtracting. We will then move onto the all important skills associated with Money and Time, any chance you have to practise these at home will be very beneficial.



English



This is a great half term with the pupils learning about playscripts! They will have a chance to read some and do some drama around them which should be good fun. They will also get a chance to write some of their own!

RSHE

We will be learning about healthy lifestyles including the importance of sleep, this could generate some interesting discussions at home! We will then explore how being active can also make us feel happier.



Science

We will be starting our biology units which will focus on how living things move. We will cover topics such as the skeletal system, the muscular system and how these two work together to allow us to move. The students will take part in experiments elated to these topics.

PE

In the first half term, Pine Class will be practising their Athletics skills in preparation for Sports Day. They will learn to master basic movements including running, jumping, throwing as well as developing balance, agility and coordination, and begin to apply these in a range of activities. Pine Class will also be trying out some foot golf.



Other subjects:

Lots of interesting areas for the pupils to look at over the next few weeks including studying the Surrealists in Art as well as creating their own 3D fantasy animal.

In RE, we will explore the creation story and how it fits (or doesn't) with scientific theory - lots of good discussions to be had!

In Food Technology we will be cooking recipes using a variety of different pulses and beans as well as learning about where they come from.

In Topic, we will be focusing on the voting system in the 1800s and learn about the Suffragettes and what they fought for.

In Computer Science the children will look at Programming and using HTML - al language used for describing the structure of Web pages to publish online documents .

In Outdoor Learning, the children will be enjoying the wonderful school grounds and looking for minibeasts and in Music and Dram we'll be preparing for Strandfest!
