#### RSHE

We will be looking at different ways relationships can be ended and explore feelings that this could cause and strategies for coping with this. We will continue with our written work which will be extended by our mature, respectful and enlightening class discussions.

#### Science

The students will continue working towards their ELC qualification. We will be completing their various bits of coursework and preparing for the tests. The students will cover topics such as photosynthesis, the conditions required for plants to grow and then use this information to carry out an investigation and analyse their findings.

#### PE

Students will be moving onto learning the rules and techniques to serve, forehand, backhand and volley in Badminton. They will also build on previous learning for Volleyball by focusing on keeping the ball in the air using the dig and set shot techniques. They will try out some Gymnastics/ Aerobics type activities using different equipment.
